Albert J. Bustetter, 92, of Wapakoneta, died 8:45 a.m., Fri. July 19, 2013, at Auglaize Acres. He was born July 27, 1920, in Wapakoneta, the son of John & Frances (Fischer) Bustetter, who preceded him in death. On June 5, 1946, he married Evelyn A. Seitz, and she died July 16, 2009.
