Alma Anna (Feil) Camper, 103, of Wapakoneta, died 7:45 a.m., Fri. March 16, 2012, at The Gardens, Wapakoneta. She was born April 9, 1908, in Auglaize Co., the daughter of William & Anna (Aufderhaar) Feil. A 1925 graduate of Blume High School, she was the last surviving member of her class.
