Annie attended St. Joseph Elementary and graduated from St. Joseph High School in 1941. She was a life-long member of St. Joseph Catholic Church, serving as the president of the Immaculate Conception Sodality, working at

God's Storehouse, and serving as a Eucharistic distributor. She loved the 4th of July Festival and was well known for her volunteer work there. In the community, she was best known as a clerk in the downtown J.C. Penney store. Annie started with the company in July of 1945 and retired August 2, 1982, with 39 years of service. She was a member of the Wapakoneta Senior Citizens and spent her retirement as she did her life, fishing, traveling, and gardening, bird watching and drinking beer. Annie was known for her quick, humorous, sometimes off-color remarks which brought laughter to all those around her.

Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m., Saturday, January 26, 2019, at the Eley Funeral Home & Crematory, St. Rt. 501, in Wapakoneta, with Deacon Nick Jurosic presiding.
