



Arlan Lee Walker

Arlan L. Walker, 78, of Wapakoneta, died peacefully at his home, 4:20 a.m., Sat. Oct. 23, 2021. He was born Oct. 16, 1943, in Charleston, WV, the son of Breman Clarence & Beulah Mae (Holmes) Walker, who preceded him in death. On Nov. 4, 1972, he married Doris Jean Sherven, and she survives.

Arlan was a member of the Wapakoneta V.F.W. Post #8445, and the Amvets Post #333. His other memberships included the Hamer Lodge, #167 F. & A.M.; the Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite, Valley of Dayton; the Antioch Shrine, Dayton, OH; and the Kentucky Colonels. He always was willing to help someone, and enjoyed fishing, hunting, woodworking, gardening, and traveling. Arlan was an excellent cook, and one of his favorite dishes was his biscuits and gravy. He liked country music, especially George Jones, and spending time with his grandchildren.

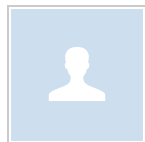

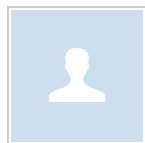
