It is with extreme sadness, we announce the passing of Ashley L. Miller, 38, of Celina, Ohio. Ashley was a bright light in this world and will be deeply missed by many. Ashley passed away at 1:22 p.m. on Saturday, August 12, 2023, at the Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center surrounded by her family. She bravely fought multiple autoimmune diseases resulting in a liver transplant, but unfortunately succumbed to post-op complications.

She was born November 21, 1984 in St. Marys, Ohio, the daughter of Sheila Miller, Kenneth Holden, and step-father Larry Rhodes. Her mother preceded her in death and Larry Rhodes survives in Celina.
