



Dennis Michael Griffin

August 14, 1950 - August 17, 2025

Dennis Michael Griffin passed away peacefully at Lima Memorial Health System on August 17, 2025, just days after celebrating his 75th birthday. Born on August 14, 1950, to the late Charlie W. Griffin Sr. and Gladys Curry Griffin, Dennis was raised in faith as a member of Good Samaritan Missionary Baptist Church from a young age. He attended Lucy C. Laney High School, and upon graduation, proudly joined the United States Navy. While serving aboard the USS Saint Paul, Dennis became a member of the ship's boxing team—winning a few, losing a few, but always enjoying the sport and camaraderie.

After his military service, Dennis moved to Long Beach, California, where he attended Long Beach College and graduated in 1975. He went on to work as an engineer at Procter & Gamble, later transferring to Lima, Ohio, in 1987, where he remained until his retirement.

Dennis was known for his love of storytelling and spending time with loved ones. His sharp wit, sense of humor, and welcoming personality made him someone others naturally gravitated toward. He had a gift for making people laugh and feel at ease.

He is survived by his fiancé and life partner, Goldie Stevens; his children, Michael Griffin (Nina) and Michelle Griffin; his sister, Carolyn Boone; brothers, Carl Griffin Sr. (Carrie) and Darryl Griffin (Lorine); and grandchildren, Alexis, Kaden, Kinsley, and Brayden. He also leaves behind a host of cousins, nieces, nephews, and friends.

Dennis was preceded in death by his brothers, Charlie W. Griffin Jr. (Lorice) and Alfred T. Griffin Sr. (Nancy); and sisters, Evelyn Melton (Alvin) and Patricia Caine (Robert), brother-in-law, William Boone, and sister-in-law, Yvonne Griffin.

Dennis will be remembered for his generous heart, his unforgettable life stories, and his singing voice, which could fill a room with joy no matter the song. His memory will live on in the lives he touched and the stories shared by those who knew and loved him.

Funeral services will be 4:00 p.m., Thursday, August 21, 2025, at the Eley Funeral Home & Crematory, St. Rt. 501, Wapakoneta, with his sister-in-law, Lorice Oates Griffin of Augusta, Georgia, officiating. Michael, Michelle, and Goldie – We all have so much to remember about Dennis.

Dennis was smart, sharp and witty. I'm convinced he knew every R&B song recorded in the '60s and '70s, at least the first two or three verses. Bebe and I are really going to miss those verses he'd sing around the house whenever he visited us in Evans. Sometimes after a meal, Dennis was the first to get up from the table and start gathering the plates and humming one of his favorite songs. After Bebe and Dennis finished in the kitchen, all of us would sit around the kitchen table and laugh and talk for hours.

Dennis would tell us about their garden, (Goldie's Garden) or the latest remodeling project he and Goldie had going on. And when it came to sports, I honestly think Dennis could've given Stephen A. Smith a run for his money. But there was just one thing we could never see eye to eye on — I could never get Dennis to root for the Georgia Bulldogs or the SEC. Still, every time he called, and that bright red shirt popped up on my phone, I'd smile and think, that shirt would look a lot better with a big Georgia "G" on it.

I'll miss those calls. I'll miss those conversations — the ones where we'd laugh about all the wild things we did as kids, always pushing the limits.

I remember last March; I told Dennis about an event where I was going to be honored. He mentions to me that he wasn't going to miss it because he had already missed too many family moments. At the time, I didn't realize how sick Dennis truly was, but he still came. Words can't express how much that meant to me and our entire family. I'll never forget it.

When I left Dennis bedside at Lima Memorial that Tuesday afternoon, August 12th, heading back to Augusta, Dennis told me to take care of myself — and that he loved me. I said the same to him, and we hugged. I left his bedside with tears and that hour drive to the Dayton Airport was the longest 100 miles I've ever traveled.
