She was active in local, state, and national teacher's associations; church groups, official boards, and commissions. She traveled in many foreign countries and most of the United States. Her recent hobbies included music, and reading, both biographical and inspirational. Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m., Thur. March 15, 2012, at First United Methodist Church, at the corner of Glynwood and Hamilton Rds., Wapakoneta; Pastors Mary Bushong and R. J. Davis officiating. Burial will be in the Dunkirk Cemetery.
