



## Elizabeth P. Hicks

November 20, 1915 - November 23, 2009

Elizabeth P. Hicks, 94, of Wapakoneta, died 7:50 p.m., Mon. Nov. 23, 2009, at St. Rita's Medical Center, Lima. She was born Nov. 20, 1915, in Elizabethtown, KY, the daughter of Ernest E. & Maude (Read) Perry, who preceded her in death. On May 16, 1936, she married C.M. Hicks, and he died in 1984.
