



## Emmett H. Shoup

June 8, 1919 - June 1, 2010

Emmett H. Shoup, Sr., 90, of Wapakoneta, died 8:30 a.m., Tues. June 1, 2010, at Auglaize Acres. He was born June 8, 1919, in Clay Twp., Auglaize Co., the son of Charles & Mary (Dieringer) Shoup-, who preceded him in death. On Feb. 23, 1941, he married Evelyn I. Katter, and she died May 20, 2009. Emmett retired in 1974, after 34 years service with Goodyear Tire & Rubber Co., St. Marys. While at Goodyear, he received the Litchfield Order of Merit for saving another man's life. He was a W.W. II veteran of the U.S. Army, and served in the European Theater. He was a member of the Trinity Lutheran Church, Moulton, the Wapakoneta Lions Club, a life member of the American Legion, Post #444, New Knoxville, OH, and a life member of the V.F.W. Post #9289, St. Marys, OH. He served as market master at the Farmer's Market, Wapakoneta. His hobbies included gardening and playing cards with his family. Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m., Sat. June 5, 2010, at Trinity Lutheran Church, Moulton, OH, Pastor Mark Bauer officiating. Burial is to follow in the Resthaven Memory Gardens, near Moulton, where military rites will be
