Gaynell Mae Market, 94, of Wapakoneta, died 8:00 p.m., Mon. Aug. 5, 2013, at her residence. She was born August 16, 1918 in St. Marys, Ohio to Ernest and Ilo (Sherman) Barber, who preceded her in death. Gaynell lived in the town of Wapakoneta until her marriage to Norman Market in 1938 when they moved to the farm that had belonged to Norman's grandfather.
