Herbert Wayne Brookhart, 90, of Wapakoneta, died 1:20 a.m., Thurs. Jan. 12, 2012, at Lima Memorial Health System. He was born June 9, 1921, in Auglaize Co., the son of Dorwin & Ethel (Burnfield) Brookhart. On April 14, 1946, he married Betty A. Hixenbaugh, and she survives.
