Jack jumps on with a stick then me with mine. We start to row and about 1/4 of the way down to Jacks grandmas house a log comes loose. Then another and another. Jack is freaking out trying to stay on this thing and save it. He has me trying to hold one end while he tries to hold the rest together at the other end. By 1/2 way to his grandmas the other end of the raft starts to untie also. Now Jack is mad. He goes over to the other edge and the whole raft comes apart in the middle of the river. Into the river he goes with me soon behind. I think I'm gonna drown and Jack yells stand up and we are like only in 3 or 4 ft of water lol. We walk over to the bank totally soaked look at each other all full of river mud and just start laughing so hard at each other. We walk back to our bikes and Jack looks at me and laughs and says well I don't think we will try that again. We get on our bikes and start down Water street and a chopper motorcycle with long forks out the front goes flying by us. Jack was like WOW I want to do that to my bicycle and so begins his new idea. But that is another story. We had just reconnected this year on facebook and was going to get together shoot some pool and talk about old days. But with me at a new job and working on my place I put it off to long. But know this Jack was a awesome friend to me in them days. We had many many great times together back then. I will cherish those memories of our friendship. Jack was true friend. He will be missed. I wish you and your familys all the best in getting through this vert difficult time.
