Jacqueline Ann "Jackie" (Foor) Sauer, age 68, formerly of Waynesfield and Mansfield, OH, passed on to Glory, Sept. 16, 2022, in St. Marys, GA. She was the eldest daughter of the late Donivan Bennett & JoAnn (Cook) Foor.

Survivors include her daughter, Angela (Dean) Sims, and son, Donivan Joseph (Laurel) Sphar, grandchildren, Garrett Sims and Cordelia Sphar. Other survivors include her older brother, Mark Steven (Dawn) Foor, her younger sisters, Melody Jo (Sam) Eusebio, and Rene' (David) Coy, and several nieces and nephews.

Jackie was a 1972 graduate of Waynesfield-Goshen High School and later received a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Mt. Vernon Christian College. She retired from the Mansfield Correctional Facility after 22 years of service as a case worker. Her years were dedicated to volunteering as a victim's advocate for a domestic violence shelter and as a representative for parents of murdered children and human trafficking. Jackie won the mayoral award for "Volunteer of the Year" for victims' awareness. Her hobbies included marshal arts, the love of nature, and was a dedicated Buckeyes fan. Jackie was a member of the Wesleyan Church of Mansfield.

Funeral services will be 11:00 a.m., Wed. Sept. 28, 2022, at the Eley Funeral Home & Crematory, Waynesfield Chapel, with Pastor Ray Selden officiating.

Burial is to follow in the Willow Branch Cemetery, Waynesfield. The family will receive friends 4-8 p.m., Tues. Sept. 27, and 9-11 a.m., Wed. at the funeral home in Waynesfield.
