Jerome J. "Jerry" Fisher, 72, of Wapakoneta, died 11:59 a.m., Wed. Feb. 18, 2015, at his home with his family at his side. He was born Aug. 15, 1942, in Lima, the son of Franklin J. & Laretta K.
