



Jessica Wilder Hoskins

December 6, 1959 - June 3, 2025

From the day Jessica Wilder Hoskins, 65, came into this world on December 6, 1959 in Idalou, TX, until she left it on June 3, 2025 at her home in Sidney, OH, her life was defined by determination and fiery tenacity.

The youngest daughter of the late Nicholas and Virginia (Castillo) Perez, Jessica's tough exterior deftly concealed a tender heart. She was a fierce advocate for justice and those who needed her help, which led her to pursue a career in the Army from 1991 to 1995. While in the Army she served as a chemical operations specialist, earning several badges and accolades along the way.

Jessica followed her military tenure with work as a chemical process operator, working for the Postal Service in Colorado, and in quality control for General Motors. She was preceded in death by brothers, Joe Perez, Ruben Perez and Noel Balderaz.
