Joseph Merle Carter, 96, of rural Wapakoneta, died 7:32 a.m., Wed. July 20, 2022, at Lima Memorial Health System, with his family at his side. He was born Feb. 14, 1926, in Waynesfield, OH, the son of the late Everett & Hattie (Miller) Carter. While stationed with the U.S. Army in Wiesbaden, Germany, Merle met his beautiful wife, Helene Nikolaenko. They were married Sept. 23, 1951, and she preceded him in death on June 4, 2013.

Post #395, Waynesfield. He loved telling stories of his time in the service to his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren. He also enjoyed playing euchre, mowing grass, caring for his vegetable garden, and watching the Cleveland Indians.
