Judith "Judy" Lee Quellhorst, 79, of Wapakoneta, passed away at 8:31 p.m., Sun., March 22, 2020, at the Mercy Health – St. Rita's Medical Center, Lima, following a sudden illness. She was born Oct. 19, 1940, in North Baltimore, OH, the daughter of Frederick E. & Goldie (Barnes) Parish, who preceded her in death. On Jan. 5, 1958, Judy married her high school sweetheart, Wayne A. Quellhorst. They were married over 62 years.

As a young girl, Judy attended the Williamson School, until the 4th grade. As a fourth grader the whole school walked to their new school at Centennial Elementary, and attended there until the 6th grade. She graduated from Blume High School in 1958, the last class to do so.
