



Julian Charles Koenig

February 6, 1921 - August 29, 2013

Julian C. Koenig, 92, of Wapakoneta, died 4:55 p.m., Thurs. Aug. 29, 2013, at Joint Twp. District Memorial Hospital, St. Marys, OH. He was born Feb. 6, 1921, in Wapakoneta, the son of William C. & Katherine (Frankenburg) Koenig, who preceded him in death.
