Larry Joseph "Joe" Winget Jr., 65, peacefully went to his heavenly home surrounded by his loved ones on Thursday, January 1, 2026, at his home in rural Wapakoneta, Ohio.

Joe was born in Lima, Ohio, on July 15, 1960, to Larry J. Winget and Alicia J. (Market) Winget, who survive him. He is survived by his wife, Kathy (Lewis), and their four children, Aaron (Trea) Winget, Meranda (Kenneth) Hill, Sarah (Buzz) Suuppi, and Rebecca (Jonathan) Gingiloski. They have nine grandchildren, four great-grandchildren, and many nieces and nephews.
