Margaret E. Tidd, 84, of Montra, passed away on February 26, 2026, after a courageous battle with cancer during a brief stay at Logan Acres in Bellefontaine, Ohio.

Margaret was born on November 3, 1941, to the late Gilbert and Leona (Serr) Schumann. On December 1, 1962, she married Jack H. Tidd, who preceded her in death on March 31, 2013. During their 50 years of marriage, they created many cherished memories traveling and spending time with family and friends.

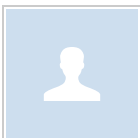

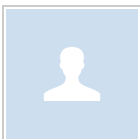
