November 2, 1927 - April 10, 2010

Marvin D. Katter, of rural Wapakoneta, died at 5:12 p.m. Saturday, April 10, 2010, at Lima Memorial Hospital. He was born November 2, 1927, in Auglaize County, the son of Martin and Frances (Steva) Katter, who preceded him in death. On November 14, 1948, in Waynesfield, he married Marjorie Lavone Hunter, his wife of 61 years, and she survives in Wapakoneta.
