Maxine E. Doorley Horman, 97 of Wapakoneta, died 11:45 p.m., Thurs. Nov. 19, 2015, at The Gardens of Wapakoneta. She was born Oct. 31, 1918, in Wapakoneta, the daughter of Mike & Anna (Brands) Doorley. On June 14, 1939, she married Edward C. "Ed" Horman at St. Patrick Catholic Church, Glynwood, and he died March 1, 2004.

She was also a life member of the V.F.W. Post #8445, Auxiliary, and a life member of the D.A.V. Auglaize Co. Chapter #73, Auxiliary. She served as commander and senior-vice commander for several years with the

D.A.V. Auxiliary. After her retirement, she served as a greeter for funeral masses at St. Joseph, and helped with masses at the area nursing homes. Her hobbies included shopping, reading the newspaper, cooking, needlepoint, and helping people.
