



## Ned A. Doering

April 23, 1941 - July 15, 2010

Ned A. Doering, 69, of rural Wapakoneta, died 4:40 a.m., Thurs. July 15, 2010, at the Ohio State University Medical Center, Columbus, OH. He was born April 23, 1941, in Lima, the son of Arthur & Lois (Brookhart) Doering, who preceded him in death. On Jan. 25, 1964, he married Ruth E. Kentner, and she survives. Other survivors include, 2 sons, David A. (Amy) Doering, Knoxville, TN, Mark A.
