Ned was a graduate of New Bremen High School, and attended Heidelberg University and The Ohio State University. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force. Ned worked as an electrical engineer with North American Rockwell Missile Guidance Systems, and in 1973 began working at Crown Equipment, retiring after 27 years of service. He moved to the Dammeyer Family Farm in 1973. Ned owned 22 patents. He used his engineering abilities to invent things to improve the farm. He also designed various items to beautify Lois & Ned's new home in Wapakoneta. He was a member of the United Church of Christ, New Bremen, where he served on church council. He also served as president of the New Bremen Board of Education. Ned was a member of the board of directors at Midwest Electric. His other memberships include the Wapakoneta Breakfast Optimist Club, the Wapakoneta Country Club, and the Wapakoneta V.F.W. Post #8445. Ned was an avid fan of The Ohio State University.
