



Robert L. "Bob" Brandt

July 20, 1925 - July 21, 2010

Robert L. "Bob" Brandt, 85, of Wapakoneta, went to be with the Lord, 8:30 a.m., Wed. July 21, 2010, at Wapakoneta Manor. He was born July 20, 1925, in Wapakoneta, the son of Louis & Bernice (Colter) Brandt, who preceded him in death. A 1943 graduate of Blume High School, Bob at the age of 18 he was drafted into the U.S. Army and fought in the Battle of the Bulge and in Germany. He was then sent to Japan for 6 months serving our country for 2 ½ years. After a 3 month whirlwind courtship, on June 19, 1949 he married the love his life, Marguerite "Marge" Sheely, and she survives in Wapakoneta. In 1970, Bob gave his life to Jesus Christ. His life was a testimony of his relationship with Jesus. He loved God's Word and read it everyday. Brandt & Sons Auto Sales, Wapakoneta, and later worked as a rural mail carrier with the U. S. Postal Service. Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m., Mon. July 26, 2010, at the Bayliff & Eley Funeral Home, St. Rt. 501, Wapakoneta, Pastor Dan Holbrook officiating. Burial is to follow in the Resthaven Memory Gardens, near Moulton, OH, where military rites will be conducted by the Wapakoneta
