Robert F. "Bob" George, 93, of Botkins, OH, died 8:10 a.m., Wed. June 18, 2014, at St. Rita's Medical Center, Lima. He was born Dec. 28, 1920, in Auglaize Co., the son of Frank & Mary (Veit) George, who preceded him in death. On June 8, 1946, he married Evelyn A. Wieging, and she survives.
