Roger L. Carnes, 54, of Wapakoneta, died 2:55 p.m., Tues. April 24, 2012, at the Lima Memorial Health System following a sudden illness. He was born Sept. 2, 1957, in Lima, OH, the son of Emmett & Theresa (Benny) Carnes. His mother survives in Wapakoneta and his father is deceased. He was a 1975 graduate of Wapakoneta Senior High School. Roger never met a stranger, and was a loving and caring person. He enjoyed racing, NASCAR, and muscle cars. He will be remembered as an organ donor with Lifeline of Ohio. Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m., Sat. April 28, 2012, at the Bayliff & Eley Funeral Home, St. Rt. 501, Wapakoneta, Pastor Phyllis Fetzner officiating. Burial will follow in the Fairmount Cemetery.
