Ruthann Wells, 78, died peacefully in her home on November 29 at 5:20am surrounded by her family. Ruthann was born on August 30, 1937 to the late Philip and Pearl (Hale) Hut in Wheeler, Michigan. On August 20, 1960 she married Robert Wells who survives.

In 2012, Ruthann was diagnosed with Multiple Myeloma and made it her life's

work to understand and beat her illness.
