Sue A. Fox, 72, of Wapakoneta, went to be with The Lord at 11:50 a.m., Easter Sunday, March 31, 2013, at Van Wert Inpatient Hospice Center, Van Wert, OH. She was born Oct. 13, 1940, in Dayton, OH, the daughter of James & Martha (Kipker) Williams. Her mother survives in Land O'Lakes, FL, and her father is deceased. Sue graduated from Olivet Nazarene University, Kankakee, IL., in May of 1962. On Aug. 18, 1962, she married Rev. Larry Fox, and he survives in Wapakoneta. She was actively involved with him in his pastoral ministry for 50 years. Survivors include, 3 children, Susan (William) Walter, Lima; Jayma (Daniel) Dodds, Anna; & Stephen (Darci) Fox, Belle Center, OH, 5 grandchildren, Jacob, Isaac, & Luke Dodds, and Marina & Avery Fox, 3 brothers, James (Vicki) Williams, Pendleton, IN; Ray Williams, Ft. Lauderdale, FL, Lon (Sue) Williams, Land O'Lakes, FL. Sue was the Administrative Coordinator for the Northwestern Ohio District Church of the Nazarene, St. Marys, OH. She served on the Board of Trustees at Mount Vernon Nazarene University since Jan. 2000. She had been actively involved in church missions since her youth. She served 27 years as the District Nazarene Missions International (NMI) President and on the General Church NMI council for 8 years. In honor of her service and passion for others, the Fox Library and Research Center was built in 2007 on the campus of Asia Pacific Nazarene Theological Seminary in Manila, Philippines. She was a member of the Wapakoneta Church of the Nazarene. Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m., Thurs. April 4, 2013, at the Nazarene District Center, 272 Jack
